



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN ATENEO DE MANILA UNIVERSITY AND UNIVERSITAS DIPONEGORO

In accordance with a mutual desire to promote international academic cooperation and educational exchanges Ateneo de Manila University, hereinafter referred to as "ADMU" and Universitas Diponegoro, hereinafter referred to as "UNDIP" agree to cooperate through research and study in furtherance of the advancement of learning as stated below:

ADMU and UNDIP will endeavor to cooperate in joint educational programs and research projects. To the extent feasible, both parties will encourage direct contact and cooperation between their faculty members, departments, and research institutes under provisions of this agreement.

ARTICLE 1.

ADMU and UNDIPagree to promote the following activities in order to mutually enhance each other's educational, academic and research activities:

- 1. Exchange of faculty members and researchers,
- 2. Exchange of undergraduate and graduate students,
- 3. Exchange of information and academic resources that are of mutual interest,
- 4. Activities such as collaborative research, joint symposia and guest lectures.

ARTICLE 2.

Matters pertaining to the implementation of the exchange based on this agreement shall be negotiated and agreed upon by representatives of the two parties. Arrangements for specific visits, exchanges, and other forms of cooperation will be developed jointly and will be agreed upon for each specific case. Any ongoing student exchanges will require a supplementary agreement, specifying the terms and nature of the student exchange.

ARTICLE 3.

No monetary consideration will be exchanged between the institutions who are parties hereto. Both parties understand all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.

ARTICLE 4.

This agreement is valid for five years and becomes effective on the date that it is signed by the official representatives of both institutions. This agreement may be reviewed at any time and any modifications concerning the present agreement may be made only by mutual consent in writing between authorized representatives of the parties. At the end of the five-year period, it may be renewed subject to mutual consent in writing. Either institution may terminate the agreement by providing written notice to the other at least 90 days before.

ARTICLE 5.

Both parties agree that ADMU and UNDIP will be prepared to answer and defend only that responsibility and resultant legal liability, involving personal injury and property damage, which is based upon or arises from their respective negligent acts or omissions which may occur in connection with this agreement.

ARTICLE 6.

This agreement will be administered by the International Office at UNDIP and by the Office of International Relations at ADMU.
