

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR STUDENT MOBILITY
BETWEEN
GYEONGSANG NATIONAL UNIVERSITY, REPUBLIC OF KOREA
AND
UNIVERSITAS DIPONEGORO, INDONESIA
NOMOR : 873/UN7.5.7.2/KS/2022**

Gyeongsang National University, Republic of Korea, Universitas Diponegoro, Indonesia, have agreed to enter into the following Memorandum of Agreement for Student Mobility based on the Memorandum of Understanding between the two institutions which was concluded on May 6, 2019.

Article 1 General Terms and Conditions

Nominated exchange students must be registered as full time undergraduate or graduate students at their home university and shall be registered as full-time non-degree students at the host university.

Article 2 Duration of Stay

1. The standard duration of stay for exchange students shall be either one semester or a full academic year.
2. Upon completion of study at the host university, exchange students shall return to their home university.

Article 3 Numbers of Exchange Students

1. Each university may send and accept up to ten (10) undergraduate or postgraduate students each year under this agreement. However, the number of exchange students can vary upon consent from both universities.
2. Two single-semester students shall be counted as the equivalent of one full-year student.
3. If an imbalance exists in the number of exchange students sent to the other university, a balance of incoming and outgoing exchange participants shall be maintained over a period of three years.

Article 4 Selection of Exchange Students and Acceptance Procedures

1. Each university shall inform the other party of its exchange application procedures and deadlines in a timely manner each year. Each university agrees to abide by the other's procedures and deadlines.
2. The students participating in the exchange program shall be selected initially by the home university in accordance with the standard of its study abroad procedures and shall be

recommended to the host university. The host university shall reserve the right to make a final decision on the admissibility of each student nominated for the exchange program.

Article 5 Study Program

Each student shall follow the study program at the host university in consultation with academic advisors of both home and host universities. Depending on the study program, language requirements and/or other prerequisites may be imposed.

Article 6 Assessment, Academic Record and Accreditation

1. The host university shall evaluate the academic performance of each exchange student according to its academic regulations and shall send to the home university the official academic record/transcript of each exchange student at the conclusion of each semester, no later than six weeks after the last day of final examinations.
2. The granting of credits for studies undertaken at the host university shall be at the discretion of the home university in accordance with its own policies and regulations.

Article 7 Tuition and Other Fees

1. Exchange students shall pay tuition to their home university and shall be exempt from application, admission and examination fees and tuition at the host university.
2. Apart from the above-mentioned fees, exchange students shall be responsible for their own expenses including accommodation, travel, health care and miscellaneous personal expenses, etc.

Article 8 Health Insurance

1. Exchange students shall be required to carry adequate health and accident insurance covering the whole exchange period in the host country.
2. The cost of any medical insurance required hereunder, as well as any medical expenses not covered by such insurance, shall be the personal responsibility of the exchange student.

Article 9 Accommodation

1. The host university shall provide each exchange student with a guaranteed housing arrangement prior to their arrival at the host university, subject to availability, at normal standard fees.

2. If housing arrangements cannot be made or an exchange student declines this pre-arranged housing, the host university shall endeavor to provide assistance and information in finding other suitable accommodation.

Article 10 Visa Arrangements

The host university shall assist its guest exchange students, to the fullest extent possible, in obtaining visas and other documents required by the government of the host country.

Article 11 Exchange Student Obligations and Host University Rights

1. Exchange students shall be required to observe the rules and regulations set forth by the host university as well as the immigration regulations and laws of the host country.
2. In the event of any breach of these rules and laws, the host university shall have the right to terminate the participation of the related student's exchange program. However, such decision shall be made through prior consultation with the home university.

Article 12 Commencement, Renewal and Termination

1. This agreement shall become effective upon the date of its signing by both parties and shall remain in force for a period of five years from the date of signing.
2. This agreement shall be subject to revision and modification by mutual written agreement and may be terminated by either party at any time for any reason upon six month's advance notice to the other party in writing.
3. In the absence of six month's written notice of annulment to the other party, the agreement shall be renewed automatically for successive additional periods of five years.
4. If there is a difference in the number of students exchanged between the two universities after the one university's notice to end the agreement, the other university who dispatched a small number of students shall send additional students to the other university so that it can be adjusted within two years after the agreement ends.
5. Notwithstanding the termination of this agreement for any reason, each university agrees that it will continue to fulfill its responsibilities to exchange students already registered at their university until the completion of their particular exchange period.


Article 13 Authentic Text
