A quality academic atmosphere creates a positive climate conducive to academic activities, interaction between lecturers, students, educational staff and laboratory staff to optimize educational process. Taking these things into consideration then Universitas Diponegoro sets standards for academic atmosphere serve as guidelines and benchmarks for university leaders, faculties, departments, and study programs, as well as lecturers who are all responsible for creating a conducive academic atmosphere

3. DEFINITION OF TERMS

The academic atmosphere is an atmosphere that is able to create a conducive climate to academic activities, and supports interaction between lecturers, students, educational staff and educational laboratory staff to optimize the educational process.

4. STANDARD CONTENT STATEMENT

- Undip has academic atmosphere policy guidelines (autonomy science, academic freedom, freedom of the academic platform with clear definition and implementation and reviewed every 5 (five) year.
- Undip carries out outreach regarding academic atmosphere policies to the academic community, especially to every new student every early academic year.
- The faculty provides infrastructure, facilities and programs for the sake of creating academic interaction between the academic community and representative campus residents.
- Faculties and Heads of Study Programs create programs and activities outside the learning process to create an atmosphere conducive academics every year.
- Undip establishes policy guidelines regarding publication involving research and community service involved lecturers and students in journals or other media every year.
- The faculty organizes seminars or similar activities scheduled for lecturers and students at least every semester.

- 8. The Study Program carries out intellectual activities (activities of poverty alleviation, environmental conservation, improving community welfare,

overcoming economic, social, political, cultural, etc.) problems with the community empowerment system.
